Charity Guidelines

Notice of Availability of Uncompensated Medical Care

Lynn County Hospital District will provide at least \$80,000.00 uncompensated care this fiscal year. This care is available to individuals who cannot afford to pay for their medical care and are legal residents of Lynn County.

Uncompensated services for Lynn County Hospital District are limited to all inpatient services, all outpatient diagnostic and radiological examinations, emergency room services, ambulance services and all outpatient rehab and therapy services performed by LCHD employees at the Lynn County Hospital District, and Lynn County Hospital District Clinics.

To determine eligibility of this care, LCHD uses maximum level of income for the appropriate family size which is established by the HHS income poverty guidelines. The current maximum levels of income are given below.
